Subject: House and Senate Hearings Follow-Up

February 6, 2023

At many House and Senate Finance Committee or Subcommittee hearings on the matter of agency budgets, committee members raise questions that cannot be answered at the hearing or require additional follow-up. These hearings are expected to begin in the coming days and weeks, so the Budget Office would like to clarify expectations regarding agency responses.

It is important that each agency respond to such questions expeditiously after the hearing and that such responses be in the proper format. All responses should be put into a <u>formal letter</u>. Although only one committee member may have asked a particular question, all the members should be provided with the agency's response, regardless of whether they attended the hearing. If there are multiple questions, it is generally appropriate to consolidate all questions and answers posed at the same hearing into a single document.

For the House Finance Committee, this letter should be addressed to the chair of the committee or subcommittee, with the remaining members of the committee (or subcommittee) provided a copy of the response.
